



Serving one of the largest and fastest-growing metropolitan areas in the United States, Dallas Area Rapid Transit (DART) operates a safe, efficient and effective transportation system that provides mobility, improves the quality of life and stimulates economic development.

- DART Rail is the longest light rail system in North America, comprising 90 miles of light rail and 62 stations on four lines.
- The agency operates approximately 130 bus routes serving 12,500 stops across 13 cities in its 700-square-mile service area.
- In partnership with the Fort Worth Transportation Authority (The T), DART operates the Trinity Railway Express, a 34-mile commuter rail line connecting Downtown Dallas to Downtown Fort Worth, with stops at cities in between.
- More than \$5.3 billion in private-capital transit-oriented development projects have been built, are under construction or are planned near the stations since the debut of DART Rail in 1996.
- A direct rail connection links DFW Airport Station at Dallas/Fort Worth International Airport (home of American Airlines) to Downtown Dallas. A short bus ride from Inwood/Love Field Station takes riders to and from Dallas Love Field (home of Southwest Airlines).
- DART Rail connects riders to major entertainment districts: Dallas Arts District, American Airlines Center/Victory Park, Dallas Historic West End, Kay Bailey Hutchison Convention Center/Omni Dallas Hotel, Fair Park/State Fair of Texas and Deep Ellum.
- DART has commissioned one of the nation's largest public art collections through the art elements and freestanding pieces integrated into rail stations and transit centers, including the acclaimed Traveling Man sculptures at Deep Ellum Station.




